



## Phishing Attempts Using Amazon.com

Recent phishing attempts have been received purporting to be from Amazon.com. They appear as order confirmations and provide several links to view “your account” and “learn more”; please do not click on any contained links and be sure to delete the email from your in and deleted email boxes.

The simplest way to verify if an order confirmation is really from Amazon is to check [Your Account](#) on Amazon.com.

*If the message is an order confirmation:*

1. Go to Amazon.com by typing [www.amazon.com](http://www.amazon.com) into your web browser (don't click a link in the e-mail itself).
2. Click **Your Account** in the upper-right corner.
3. Visit **Your Orders** and see if there is an order that matches the details for the one in the e-mail.

If it doesn't match an order, the message isn't from Amazon.
